## Arena Safety Measures

- All patrons to the facility are required to self-screen before entering the facility, and do not enter if feeling unwell.
- Arena capacity and spectator seating are limited to ensure proper physical distancing guidelines are being followed. Due to specific arena layouts, allowable occupancy levels may be less than 50% of posted occupancy levels.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available at each entrance.
- Masks are to be worn at all times in City of Winnipeg facilities, unless at the time of participating in physical activity.
- Individuals are asked to maintain a distance of at least two meters, at all times, from every other individual who is not in their household.
- Do not arrive more than 15 minutes before your ice reservation, or stay longer than 15 minutes after your ice reservation.
- A team/ice reservation representative must present themselves to arena staff upon entry. This individual will be responsible for tracking and controlling building occupancy related to their reservation.
- Participants are required to come dressed to play.
- Hard skate guards are highly recommended.
- Change room access will not be provided before your reservation.
- Limited capacity change room access will be provided for 15 minutes after your ice reservation.
- Access to players boxes will be limited to promote social distancing.
- Please adhere to all barriers posted, and do not move them.
- Showers are not available until further notice.
- Bring your own water; limited use of water fountains will be available.
- No spitting or dryland training.
- Staff will be following handwashing protocols and disinfecting surfaces as needed throughout the day and between user groups.

## Team Representative Responsibilities

- All ice reservations must have a team/ice reservation representative.
- The team/ice reservation representative must present themselves to arena staff upon entry.
- The team/ice reservation representative is responsible for the following:
  - Maintaining reservation capacity limits.
  - Managing 1-1 participant to adult ratio when assisting youth participants in change rooms after reservation is complete.
  - Managing entry to the arena and prohibiting reservation patrons from opening doors for other reservation groups/spectators.
  - Adhere to requests from arena staff to actively respond to reservation patrons if protocols are being breached.
